

[Q&A related to "On-campus Self-quarantine"]

Q1. How can I apply for on-campus self-quarantine facility?

A1. Within the application period (2021.07.05.~2021.07.15.), send a copy of flight ticket through e-mail (dkuglobal20@gmail.com) and submit the on-campus quarantine application via DKU portal Web-information system. Your place reservation order is confirmed when both of your application AND the copy of flight ticket are received(First come, first serve basis). Thus, please purchase your flight ticket and send the copy to us as soon as possible. Please check the on-campus quarantine announcement for more details.

Q2. Do I need a Korean (cell phone) number when I arrive Incheon International Airport?

A2. If you only have your number in your native country, apply for roaming in your native country before entering Korea. If it is impossible, you should write down your friend's number in Korea. Please write down number which you can be reached.

Q3. If my flight schedule changes, can I change the pick-up method?

A3. You can only choose one method for pick-up when you submit the application form. If there is a change in the flight schedule, please contact the International Office as soon as possible.

Q4. My flight arrives in Korea late at night, would it be possible to use the bus?

A4. **Bus pick-up is available from 7am to 8pm** based on the flight arrival time in Korea. Please be advised that it may take a few hours before boarding the bus as there will be three scheduled buses in a day.

If you arrive at dawn or late night hours beside 7am to 8pm, **you can request a Call Van reservation in the application form**, the international office will assist you to make a reservation for a 'Call Van'. Up to 2 students can ride the same 'Call Van' (will be matched with a friend arriving at a similar time), the fee for 'Call Van' must be paid directly to the driver(190,000 KRW).

Q5. I cannot eat pork(or other food) because I'm a Muslim/vegetarian/allergic to something

A5. Please write down the information in the application form. We will try to accommodate your request as much as possible. Not all requests can be considered, only religious or allergy issues will be considered.

Q6. I asked for keeping my luggage in the storage room in dormitory before I left Korea. Can I bring my luggage from the storage room upon my arrival?

A6. Luggage stored in the dormitory cannot be retrieved during your self-quarantine period and it only will be available after the self-quarantine period ends. Please claim your luggage after the quarantine and before 2021.09.10.

Q7. I was vaccinated in my home country, do I need to do self-quarantine upon arrival?

A7. Yes, mandatory. According to the Korean government's rules and regulation, all foreign

nationals are subject to do self-quarantine upon arrival in Korea. Other than that, after entering Korea, you must be tested for COVID-19 test within 24 hours and re-tested on the 13th day of quarantine.

(Please note that the self-quarantine for 14 days is mandatory even though you have been vaccinated. For personal safety purpose, students are recommended to get vaccinated (finishing first-shot of vaccination) before entering Korea.)

Q8. Other frequently asked questions

- A8. - Meals/snacks : Meals (14 days, 3 meals per day), snacks (14 days, once a day)
- Parcel delivery : Not allowed
- Food delivery : Not allowed
- Daily necessities : Essential daily supplies such as shampoo, soap, toilet papers, blankets and pillows are provided, but personal necessities such as feminine hygiene products and beauty products are not included. Please prepare the items if you need by your own.
- Laundry availability : Not allowed. Students are not allowed to leave their room and laundry soap will be provided for inner wear washing.
- Electrical adapter/converter : Not provided. please prepare it by your own as needed.

Q9. The on-campus self-quarantine facility are operated in the Cheon-an Campus, but I am a student in the Juk-jeon Campus. Will the university provide transportation to Jukjeon after the quarantine is over?

A9. Yes, the university will provide a bus for Juk-jeon campus students to go back to Juk-jeon campus after the quarantine is over.

Q10. I am a confirmed applicant for the dormitory for the next semester, can I enter the dormitory immediately after self-quarantine period is over?

A10. According to the original schedule, the date of entering the dormitory for the next semester is on 2021.08.28.(Sat), but **if you have been the confirmed applicants to enter the dormitory and were the on campus self-quarantine facility user,** you will be allowed to enter the dormitory immediately after the quarantine period. Students can enter the dormitory in advance from the end of self-quarantine, and the cost for living for that period is **at students' own expense.** If you who have not been confirmed as a resident of dormitory for the next semester, you cannot enter the dormitory after quarantine, so please find a place to stay by your own.

Q.11 I couldn't get a flight ticket between 21.08.05 – 21.08.10, the period to enter on-campus self-quarantine facility, and I bought one scheduled on a different date. In this case, can I still use the on-campus self-quarantine facility?

A11. Impossible. On-campus self-quarantine facility were arranged in accordance with the reopen date of next semester, 2021.08.30. We cannot consider the date of flight tickets for all students, and on-campus self-quarantine facility can only be operated within the

announced period. If you purchase a flight ticket which scheduled date is not within the application period, you will not be able to use the on-campus self-quarantine facility, and you will need to find a self-quarantine facility outside campus upon arrival.

Even in the case of the students who stay out of the campus to do the self-quarantine by one's self, the students should enter Korea by 2021.08.15.(Sun) to complete self-quarantine and stay on the campus.

(After the end of on-campus self-quarantine facility on 2021.08.24(Tue), will takes 2 days for disinfection and cleaning the used place.)

[Academic Schedule related Q&A]

Q. Is the 2nd semester of 2021 will be conducted fully face-to-face lecture?

A. According to the Korean Ministry of Education, face-to-face lectures are the standard for basic academic progress in the second semester of 2021. **Therefore, there are no plans to conduct online classes for international students in the 2021-2nd semesters, and most major classes will be conducted offline, face-to-face.** However, it may be changed according to the national policy due to the corona situation, so please check the notice to avoid any disadvantages.
