#### Beomjeong(梵亭), Chang Hyong(張炯) 1889.1.18 ~ 1964.12.30

Having witnessed the social chaos that followed the nation's independence, Mr. Beomjeong, Chang Hyong recognized the need to educate talented individuals armed with unwavering patriotism and devoted himself to establishing the university with Mrs. Hyedang Cho Huijae. He dedicated himself to the institution's growth after it was finally founded. He received the Order of Merit for National Foundation during the 1963 Commemoration of the Independence Movement Day ceremony in recognition of his service towards independence.

Following independence, Mrs. Hyedang Cho Huijae set out to establish a new university funded purely by domestic capital, armed with her husband's belief that education completes men and provides a solid foundation for the nation. Based on her previously established friendship with Mr. Beomjeong, Chang Hyong, she generously provided the base funds necessary for the establishment of a foundation.

Based on the ideas of human dignity and respect for human life, Dankook University Hospital has been making continuous investments in top-notch medical professionals and equipment since opening its doors in 1994 to build an exceptional system for healthcare services. Equipped with more than 1,000 beds, it is the largest university hospital in central Korea, offering medical services in 32 departments including internal medicine, surgery, OB/GYN, pediatrics, and mental health along with an emergency medical center and health examination center. It also operates the South Chungcheong Regional Trauma Center which has the facilities, equipment, and expertise needed for emergency operations and treatment of severe trauma patients, and Doctor Helicopter which extends optimal healthcare services for trauma patients in islands and remote areas with restricted access to healthcare.

# Largest Center for Cancer in central Korea (10 stories, 250 beds) Offering integrated cancer treatment from diagnosis to surgery

Eighty four billion KRW was invested to build a 250-bed Center for Cancer, which opened in 2022 as the largest center of its kind in central Korea. The center aims to protect the health of local residents from cancer, which is the leading cause of death among Koreans today.

The College of Dentistry's Jukjeon Dental Hospital opened on the Jukjeon Campus in 2010, offering services in oral and maxillofacial surgery, pediatric dentistry, orthodontics, conservative dentistry, prosthodontics, periodontics, advanced general dentistry, anesthesiology, oral medicine, and oral diagnosis. It also operates the Gyeonggi Dental Care Center for Persons with Special Needs along with specialty clinics for bimaxillary osteotomy, dental implants, TMJ (temporomandibular joint), pediatric painfree dentistry, and orthodontics.

Opened in 1984, the Dankook University Dental Hospital has become the leading dental hospital in central Korea, developing the first next-generation integrated solution in Korea and implementing cutting-edge systems such as Full-PACS, EMR videos, MDCT, and CBCT. It offers dental services in 11 departments including conservative dentistry, oral and maxillofacial surgery, prosthodontics, periodontics, orthodontics, pediatric dentistry, dental radiography, oral medicine, preventive dentistry, advanced general dentistry, and anesthesiology, and operates the Center for Dental Implants, the South Chungcheong Dental Care Center for Persons with Special Needs, and special Scaling Center.
